

From there we moved on to Africa Bike Week, for a breakfast.




We spent the rest of the day looking at different bikes and enjoying the atmosphere of the day.


We ended our weekend at the Linde's for supper and some more sharing. It was indeed an awesome, blessed weekend!



Thank you once again for your loyalty to the work of our Heavenly Father reaching out to lost souls!



Hebrews 11:1


